Helping parole leaders meet the challenges of the future.

The National Parole Resource Center (NPRC), in partnership with the National Governors Association Center for Best Practices (NGA Center), has selected four states to participate in a learning collaborative focused on strengthening evidence-based paroling practices and enhancing collaboration between governor's offices and paroling authorities:

- **Colorado**
- **Kentucky**
- **Nebraska**
- **North Carolina**

Through the learning collaborative, state teams will review latest evidence-based best practices in parole, identify strategies for strengthening their state's parole system, and explore opportunities for enhancing relationships among key criminal justice stakeholders. With assistance from the NPRC and the NGA Center, each state will develop recommendations for supporting and strengthening parole decision-making, policies, and practices. States will also examine the latest research on best practices for paroling authorities and the critical role they can play in achieving governor's public safety goals.

A learning collaborative provides an opportunity for a small group of state teams to learn the latest research on a policy topic, share best practices, identify opportunities for improvement, and develop action plans to implement these recommendations. The parole learning collaborative will commence with a Policy Summit involving teams from the four selected states on September 26-27 in Washington, DC.
