## Our Projects



The NRCJIW collaborates with government agencies to provide **technical assistance** to federal, state, and local justice systems and serves as a **clearinghouse for research and information** regarding innovative and promising practices on all issues related to gender equity in the justice system.



The GIPA was designed to expand the use of **gender-informed and evidence-based practices** for women. The assessment is conducted on-site by a team of external evaluators and provides a baseline measure of how closely the facility's policies and practices align with the prevailing research.



The GRPPA-CV provides a framework for **community corrections agencies to examine and assess** their alignment to evidence-based, gender-responsive, and trauma-informed policies and practices.
